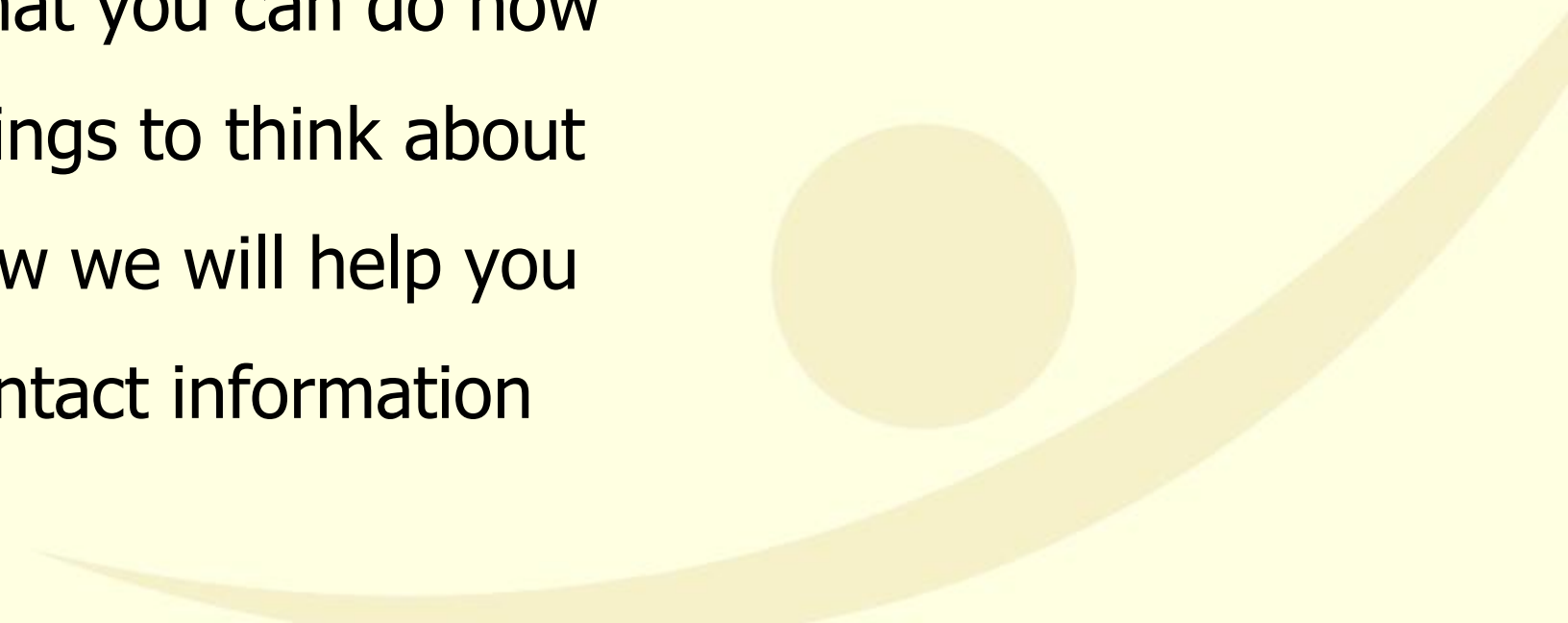

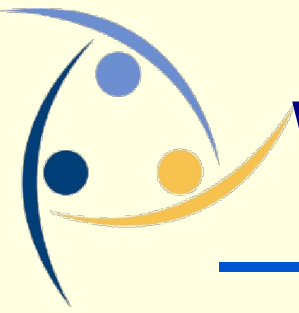

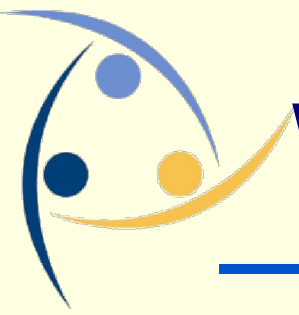

# What we will need from you

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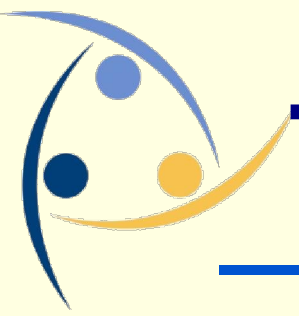
- ◆ Materials
  - ◆ Invitation messages
  - ◆ Institutional image (optional)
  - ◆ Letterhead and signature (paper mode only)
- ◆ Population file
- ◆ Updated registration info
  - ◆ Contacts
  - ◆ Calendar



# What you can do now

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- ◆ Obtain (or ask about) local IRB approval
- ◆ Make friends with your:
  - ◆ Registrar (or whoever has student data)
  - ◆ IT personnel who administers e-mail
  - ◆ Staff who work with students (Student Activities, Residence Life, librarians, etc.)
  - ◆ Influential students (student government, student leaders, etc.)



# Things to think about

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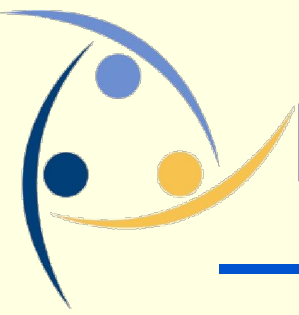
- ◆ How will you use the data?
  - ◆ Will you need to survey additional students (oversample)?
  - ◆ Will you need to identify specific groups of students ahead of time (grouping variables)?
- ◆ Will you join a consortium?
- ◆ How will you advertise the survey?
- ◆ Will you use incentives?

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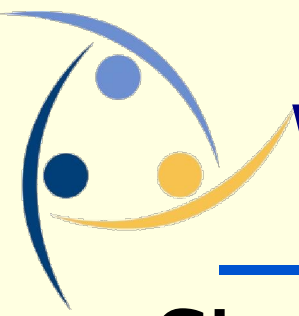

# What is a Consortium?

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- ◆ Similar institutions / Research agendas
- ◆ Minimum of 6 institutions
  - ◆ Data sharing agreement
- ◆ 20 additional questions on survey
- ◆ Consortia and Systems



# Cost for Consortium

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- ◆ Fees are charged for participation and depend on enrollment numbers
  - ◆ Less than 4,000: \$200
  - ◆ 4,000 to 7,999: \$300
  - ◆ 8,000 to 12,000: \$400
  - ◆ More than 12,000: \$500



# Timeline 2009

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- ◆ September 1, 2008
  - ◆ Last day to create a consortium/system
- ◆ September 5, 2008
  - ◆ Invitation sent to institutions for participation in a consortium and/or system
- ◆ September 30, 2008
  - ◆ Deadline for consortium/system coordinators to submit questions
- ◆ October 5, 2008
  - ◆ Deadline for institutions to enroll in consortium and/or system
