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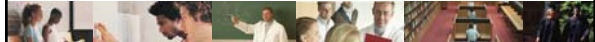

Summer	Registration
Fall	Preparation
Spring	Administration



Summer / Early Fall

- Besides the obvious, what's important about registration?
 - Start thinking about promotional strategies now!
 - Become acquainted with NSSE deadlines

Fall – Prepare Materials!

September 27 – October 28

- Provide population file (all FY & SR students)
- Create customized messages on Interface
- Submit academic calendar/create mailing schedule
- Submit logo image (optional)
- Technology (<http://nsse.iub.edu/?cid=267>)
- Fall preparations must be finalized before winter break – avoid making decisions last minute
- Begin strategy of collaboration

Spring


- Test messages sent in early January
- Post/publish promotional materials
- Coordinate with colleagues (i.e., Deans and FY Program staff), and send regular updates

Involving faculty and staff

- Developing NSSE committees
- Targeting specific faculty and staff
 - Announcements in class, at hall meetings, etc.
- Presentations to departments on NSSE data



Promotions - Involving students

- Clubs & organizations
- School newspaper
- Student TV/Radio station
- Feature students in promotional materials



IRB considerations

- Participating in NSSE is voluntary and it's important promotions don't suggest otherwise
- Limited to 5 direct recruitment attempts
- Results are confidential, not anonymous
- Incentives must be detailed in recruitment messages, and equally available to all participants
- Consult your campus IRB policy for local guidelines
